1. **Desert festival, Jaisalmer:** This is three-day event arranged by the Rajasthan Tourism Development Corporation during the month of February. It is an absolute bonanza that celebrates the delights of the desert. The atmosphere prevails with song and dance, with the artists dressed in bright colors in traditional attire illustrating the tragedies and accomplishments of the desert.
2. **Teej festival, Jaipur:** One of west India's most popular festivals, Teej comprise of two things – a woman's love for her husband and the advent of the monsoon season. The festival is marked by vibrant celebrations where the womenfolk observe fasting and apply mehndi designs on their hands.
3. **Ganguar festival, Jaipur:** this festival that consists of goddess Parvathi and her home-coming, it is celebrated with huge pomp in Rajasthan by women. Processions of a well-dressed Goddess Gauri are carried all over the city and everyone participates in it, often accompanied by elephant processions, chariots, folk song and dance and also often finishes with the sounds of fireworks in the air.
