Q: How much does the Invisalign device?

A: As with any other orthodontic treatment, the cost of Invisalign depends on many factors, including the complexity of the case of each individual patient and the duration of therapy. In general, the cost and 'slightly higher than that of metal braces and can' still be deferred during the care.

D: Invisalign really work?

A: Yes. Clinical research at the university level and at private studies worldwide have shown the effectiveness of this treatment.

Q: The insurance covers the cost of the device Invisalign?

Q: What is Invisalign?

A: Invisalign and 'an innovative <u>orthodontic</u> treatment that can straighten your teeth without metal wires. Invisalign employs a series of removable, clear, built on the bite impression of the dental patient, spanning teeth like a glove on a hand. Each mask gradually move the teeth that need to be realigned.

Q: How does Invisalign works?

A: Invisalign uses a three-dimensional computer technology which enables you to gradually complete treatment plan from the initial position of your teeth to the final. Each aligner moves teeth slowly over an interval of around 14 days, after which will be changed with the next until the teeth do not reach the chosen end position.

Q: What are the main benefits of Invisalign?

A: Here are the top Benefits of Invisalign:

- 1. The aligners are virtually invisible when worn and therefore no one will know 'that you're bringing the two.
- 2. The aligners are removable, so you can 'eat and drink what' you want, so as brushing your teeth properly to maintain proper oral hygiene (made difficult however with whalebones fixed)
- 3. The aligners are comfortable, wireless attacks it fixed, there is no problem of irritation in the mouth. The Invisalign treatment allows the patient to see their teeth move gradually and then evaluate the final result before initiating therapy.

Q: What are made aligners?

A: The masks are made of a transparent polymer, widely used in dentistry which happens to be resistant and virtually unnoticeable when worn.

Q: Invisalign and 'a new way to straighten teeth'?

A: Yes. For years both orthodontists and dentists have used similar equipment to make small dental movements. Today, thanks to advances in computer technology, Invisalign can treat a greater number of cases with greater precision.
