



# Mody University of Science and Technology

Shri. R.P Mody founded the [Mody University of Science and Technology](#) (Mody University) in 1998. The Universal Grants Commission has recognised the university (UGC). Mody University has received approval from the All India Council for Technical Education, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the Bar Council of India (BCI), and the Indian Council of Architecture. The university is spread out over a 265-acre campus. Mody University has a total faculty of 209 people and a student body of 2065 people. Undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctorate courses are available at the institute. Mody University is divided into seven schools. All of the institute's students are eligible for scholarships and placement assistance.

## Mody University Infrastructure and facilities

Students have access to a variety of amenities and infrastructure within the institute. [Mody University](#) has eight female hostels, as well as a well-equipped gym with contemporary equipment. The institute has a library with a wide range of books, periodicals, and national and international publications. Mody University's amenities include a 17-acre sportsground for students, as well as cafeterias where students may eat. The school has a healthcare centre with resident woman physicians for the professors' and students' emergency needs. Mody University offers good Wi-Fi connectivity as well as transportation in and around the city. The institution also features a moot court for hands-on learning as well as guest homes for visiting academics and students' families.

## Courses provided by Mody University

Undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctorate courses are available at the institute. The courses last anywhere from two to six years. Mody University offers a total of 107 courses. The table below lists the qualifying requirements for some of the most popular Mody University courses.

LLB	Passed graduation from any recognised board.
M.Tech	Passed graduation in relevant fields with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

MCA	Passed BCA/ bachelors in CSE or passed B.Sc/B.Com/B.A with Maths at 10+2 or graduation level..
M.Com	Passed B.Com/ BBA or an equivalent degree in the relevant field with a minimum of 50% marks.
M.Sc.	Passed graduation in a relevant field with a minimum of 50% marks.

Ph.D	Passed master's in the relevant field with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade point average in the related subject area from any recognised university.

## **Mody University Admissions**

Undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctorate programmes are all available at the institute. Mody University's admissions process differs depending on the course. Modi University, for example, admits students to B.Arch programmes based on their performance on the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) or JEE Main paper 2. Admission to Ph.D. programmes at Modi University is based on the results of the entrance test and the performance in the personal interview. The following are the admission procedures for some of the university's most popular courses:

### **BBA/ B.Com/ B.A/ B.A (Hons)/B.Sc/M.Sc/ B.Com/B.A./BBA LLB Admission Procedure at Mody University**

- Apply online and submit your application using the university's official website.
- Candidates are shortlisted based on their performance on the qualifying exams.
- Candidates who have been shortlisted are invited to a personal interview.
- For final admission, verify papers and pay the admission fee.

### **Admission Procedure for B.Tech/BCA Courses at Mody University**

- Apply for the Mody University Engineering Entrance Exam and take it (MEET).
- On the basis of MEET scores, candidates are shortlisted for participation in the counselling procedure.
- For seat allocation, candidates engage in the MEET counselling procedure.
- For final admission, verify papers and pay the admission fee.

## **Mody University's Ph.D. Admissions Procedure**

- Apply through the university's official website.
- Mody University will administer an entrance exam and an interview.
- Qualifying candidates take part in document verification and fee payment at the university level.
- Pay the admissions fees and double-check their credentials.
