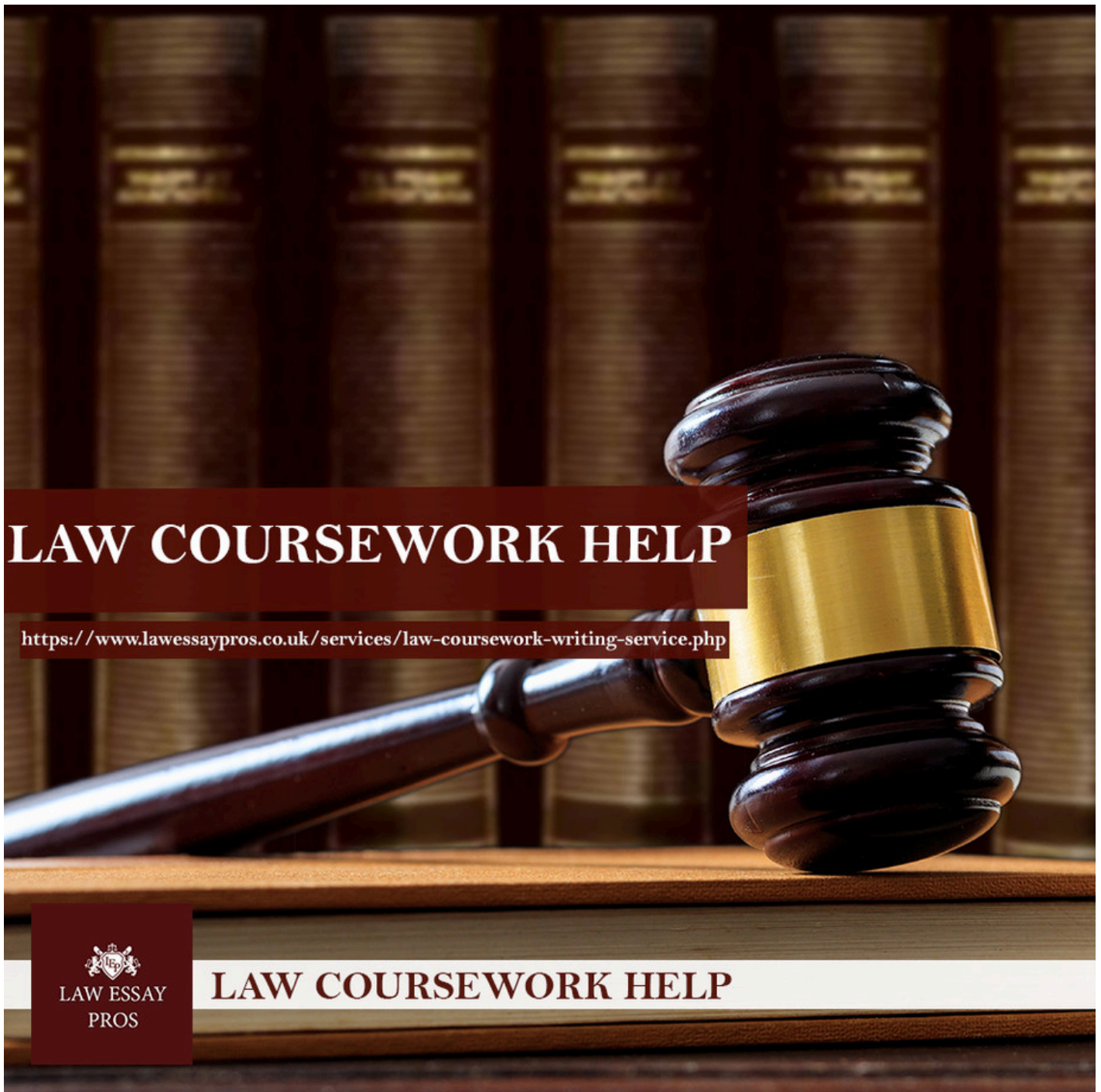




# What Are The Best Ways To Write Law Coursework?
