Top season for travel to Kenya and Tanzania is during the Wildebeest Migration. Among June and October, the crowds absolute 1.4 million monsters in the Masai Mara and here the green grass of the Mara-fields sustains them - until the appearance of the November downpours, getting back to them back south once more.

As you can imagine, nature doesn't follow tough timetables and relying upon precipitation the journey can happen at least one weeks after the fact. During an especially wet season, crowds once in a while even stay in the Serengeti and the incredible movement doesn't actually happen.
