



## Southwest airlines points refund policy

Southwest Airlines headquarters are in Dallas, Texas and is the largest low-cost airline provider in the country. The airlines were founded on 15th March 1967 by Herb Kelleher, Airs Southwest Co. In the peak season, over 60,000 workers are working, and about 4,000 flights leave in a day. The airline has 103 destinations in the USA and ten other destinations abroad. In the aviation sector, Southwest is notable because it does not charge fines for changes and alterations or cancellations of flights. Unrecoverable prices will be applied to future trips, not on the day of the journey but postponed in conformity with the no show policy of Southwest. Refundable tickets not flying on the departure date will undoubtedly be reserved for future fares or future flights as well.
