



Bench guard 'Man of 170 Billion'

It's a disappointing performance for the money invested.

Manchester City has ended its expectations for Jack Grealish. "Manchester City is making efforts to secure funds to reinforce its players," British media HITC reported on Tuesday . "For this reason, we can release Jack Grealish to the transfer market this summer."

Grealish was once one of England's best attacking midfielders. With his exceptional one-on-one individual ability, he established a reputation as a playmaker who assembles attacks in the midfield.

However, Grealish has not displayed as good performance as expected since moving to Manchester City. He played in all 50 games last season, scoring five goals and making 11 assists. Indeed, his performance was not good compared to the amount he invested in the transfer.

This season has been even more sluggish. He played in a total of 27 games, and he only had three goals and two assists.

Eventually, he lost ground in the starting lineup competition. As he lost ground in the starting lineup competition with Jeremy Toku, he spent more time sitting in the bench.
