At that point place a subsequent tennis ball into the far edge of the PVC pipe. (So now you have a tennis ball on one or the flip side of your barrel.) With everything secure inside, append the upper cap and tape it down safely. With this pressing methodology, when the transporter dispatches the line like a lance, at any rate the barrel won't come through like a lance and be gone.
