

Like many trends promoted by designers, flush-mount hobs may sound greater in a display than they would in a real kitchen. Three straightforward reasons why flush-fitting a hob is not readily chosen are:

### It is Pricey

Flush fitting a hob can be quite expensive. The cost of any kind of stone countertop will vary depending on a number of criteria. The amount of labour necessary is one of the above criteria. Therefore, the cost will increase when more polishing and channelling are needed. The installation of a low-profile hob flange requires the creation of a steep groove, which is a complicated and time-taking task. Therefore, if you'd like this functionality, it will probably cost more.

### It Can Look Messy If Done Carelessly

The fitter must leave an expansion space around the hobs because they all have the potential to become warm. Science has long shown that although cold causes items to contract, heat causes them to stretch. Your burner operates similarly. In order to accommodate this enlargement, you must leave a space if your hob is flush-mounted. Naturally, this entails

sealing the space with silicone to prevent the entry of contaminants. In some situations, this can be really unattractive. Even silicone can become soiled with time, necessitating removal and replacement with a brand-new one.

### It Needs a Professional for Installation

As we are now aware of the complications around it, installing flush-fitted hobs on your granite worktop kitchen is not a single-handed job. It requires a professional for fitting.
