



Jaylon Brunson agrees team-friendly renewal with New York Knicks

According to ESPN, New York agreed to renew the contract with Jaylon Brunson (guard, 188cm, 86kg) on the 13th (Korea Standard Time).

New York awarded Brunson a four-year, \$156.5 million contract. It is a contract that includes player options in the final year of the contract, which gives him an annual contract of about \$40 million. The contract is expected to take effect from the 2025-2026 season.

Brunson has been mulling over an extension this time, as his ongoing contract (US\$104 million for four years) is nearing its end. With player options in the final year of his contract, he could become a free agent after the upcoming 2024-2025 season. If he were to go on the transfer window, he could have received up to five years and US\$269 million in contracts. However, he signed the deal this time, not next year. [토토사이트 순위](#)

As he was able to sign an extended contract this time, he chose to stay on the current terms. If you play in New York, you can play with Dante DiVincenzo, Mikal Bridges, and Josh Hart. Those from the same university actually boast a close relationship, and they have also collaborated to win in the NCAA. In fact, it can be seen from Brunson's reaction when Hart joined in a trade.

Given his stellar performance in this season's playoffs, it does not mean that he was able to afford it. It is unclear what kind of performance he will be able to perform next year, but when his main options, Julius Randle and Anunovi, were unable to play due to injury, he played almost all of the games and displayed steady performance in the injury ward. As a result, he has decided to sign a long-term contract this time.

Considering the contract that can be won next year, there is a difference of about \$113 million, but there is uncertainty about the ability and longevity of short guards, so it can be said that they have decided to remain in New York, a big market, in those conditions. It can be seen as a smart choice because you don't know how long your high point will be maintained.

During the last season, Brunson played in all 77 games as a starting member. Playing 35.4 minutes per game, Brunson had 28.7 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 6.7 assists, which was the

best year for him. Having displayed potential as a major catcher last season, Brunson has become the ace of his team again this time. He has scored the most points on average since joining the NBA. Since he also had the most assists, he played as an option.

He consistently accompanied an average of 2.7 3-pointers with a success rate of more than 40%, and saved the team in every crisis. Thanks to his stable performance, New York was able to stay strong against the rise of its main resources. Considering his recent improvement, he could have won \$323 million for four years if he signed an extension next year and \$418 million for five years if he re-signed after the option event, but he refused.
