The liquid waste, called effluent, flows from the tank right into a distribution box, and by way of a soil absorption or 'leach'field.

An average leach field includes a series of perforated pipes buried in gravel-filled trenches. As effluent seeps through the trenches, it's filtered by earth particles and broken down by earth bacteria.

An a deep failing or malfunctioning septic system can allow disease-causing organisms and other pollutants into the environment. Unless the sludge and suspended scum are periodically pumped from the tank, even a properly designed septic system can fail.

But, for some homeowners, checking sludge and scum build-up is too objectionable a task.

They pick, alternatively, to simply have the tank pumped out, cleaned, and inspected by a professional at 3- to 5-year intervals, dependant on how big the tank, the number of individuals utilising the system and the amount and quality of solids entering the tank.

It's sometimes surprising to see what some individuals put to their septic systems: grease, cigarette butts, cat litter, just to call a few. All of these will, most definitely, clog a septic system.

The safest and best approach is to utilize only easily decomposed, one-ply toilet tissue. You can further reduce or minimize the amount of solids put in the machine by avoiding the use or installing of garbage disposal units.
