



LSG Predicted XI vs KKR: Should KL Rahul Keep The Same Playing XI?

Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) take on Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) in Match 66 of the continuous Indian Premier League (IPL) 2022 season, at the Dr DY Patil Sports Academy in Navi Mumbai on Wednesday. Right now third in the IPL 2022 Points Table with 16 places in 13 games (eight successes and five losses), LSG will plan to seal a season finisher compartment in their last association stage apparatus.

This is the way LSG could arrange versus KKR:

Quinton de Kock: The wicketkeeper-player was excused inexpensively in LSG's past apparatus against Rajasthan Royals (RR). He will expect to place in a decent presentation in the forthcoming apparatus.

KL Rahul: The LSG skipper is his side's most noteworthy run-scorer this season and is likewise second in the Orange Cap race with 469 runs in 13 apparatuses.

Ayush Badoni: Ayush Badoni will be hoping to return quickly after his brilliant duck in LSG's past trip.

Deepak Hooda: Deepak Hooda has been solid for LSG in [IPL 2022](#) and packed away 50 years in the past match.

Krunal Pandya: The all-rounder has turned into a critical machine gear-piece in KL Rahul's arrangement. He will be hoping to intrigue with both bat and ball.

Marcus Stoinis: The Australian hasn't been predictable this season and will expect to have an effect versus KKR.

Jason Holder: The all-rounder has been steady with the ball for LSG however neglected to be in great touch with the bat. He could enroll one run off two balls in his side's past game.

Dushmantha Chameera: The Sri Lankan has been in good structure this season and has taken nine wickets in 11 games.

Mohsin Khan: Mohsin Khan has been ruling for LSG in the powerplay overs and will be hoping to expand on his structure.

Avesh Khan: Avesh Khan is his side's most elevated wicket-taker in IPL 2022 with 17 excusals in 11 matches.

Ravi Bishnoi: The spinner was in great structure during the loss versus RR and took two wickets in four overs.
