- *Beyond Scholarship Program:* Vidya Chetana does not stop at providing scholarships to underprivileged children. It takes the extra step to support overall development of the beneficiaries through its various programmes such as career counselling, personality development sessions, 21st century skills training, and Employment Readiness Program, to name a few.
- *Transparency and commitment:* This **NGO working for education** is well-aware of the significance of donations. So, it maintains utmost transparency with regards to funds required to support each child.
