



'124 losses in the season' forgetting how to win 21 consecutive games with no way out

The White Sox lost 1-5 to the Oakland Athletics in an away game on Sunday. The team attempted to escape consecutive losses against the Oakland Athletics, which is ranking last in the American League West, but it was not enough. The team lost both pitching and hitting, and suffered the bitter taste of defeat once again.

He was dragged away by giving up the first run in the bottom of the first inning. He scored a point in the top of the fourth inning to tie the game. However, he instantly lost momentum. He lost two runs in the bottom of the fourth inning, falling behind 1-3. He gained ground by giving up one more run in the bottom of the sixth and eighth innings, respectively. He lost ground in the mound fight. Kai Bush, who made his big league debut as a starter, was substituted early on after allowing two hits and three runs in four innings. He had only two hits, but allowed as many as five walks, destroying himself. Batters failed to target the opposing starting pitcher JP Sears properly. He only garnered three hits, one walk, and one run during seven innings, and struck out five.

It lost 21 consecutive games. It lost 21 consecutive games, including a 2-3 defeat in the second game of a doubleheader against the Minnesota Twins on June 11. The Louisville Connors are close to winning their 26th consecutive game in 1889, the worst record in Major League history.

The loss marked 27 wins and 88 losses on the day. If he continues at the current pace, he will lose 123.97 games this season. He ranked last among the 30 teams in the Major League with a winning rate of 0.235 over the American League Central. He was 41.5 games behind the Cleveland Guardians (67 wins and 45 losses), the leading team in the American League Central. Oakland, which has led the White Sox to 21 consecutive losses, posted 47 wins and 67 losses. It ranked fifth, the lowest in the American League Western Division. He is three games shorter than the Los Angeles Angels (49 wins and 63 losses), which ranks fifth in the league.
