Building surveyors perform one of the nation's most critical functions, i.e., to ensure that a high standard of living is available to all. One of the main tasks performed by surveyors is site investigation. The <u>Site investigations</u> or Sub-Soil explorations are performed to obtain information about the subsurface conditions of the site that is proposed for construction. Soil exploration involves determining the soil profile at the site by taking soil samples and determining the engineering properties of soils and potential hazards beneath the soil.
