



Operation reporting for 18-07-13

6 puppets killed, 5 injured in Paktika PAKTIA, July 18 – A clash between Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate and the puppets of what they call ANP left 6 policemen dead and 5 others wounded in Sarhawza district of Paktika province on Wednesday.

Two of the Mujahideen are reported to have become martyred in the clash. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Bomb explosion kills 2 puppet soldiers LOGAR, July 18 – A bomb blast in the capital of Logar province killed two puppets of ANA and wounded a dozen more early Wednesday morning. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Two vehicles destroyed in attack on US-Nato convoy BAGHLAN, July 18 – Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate Wednesday attacked the invaders' military-guarded supply convoy in Baghlan-e-Markazi district of northern Baghlan province, destroying a container truck and an oil tanker. 3 killed, 2 injured as bomb hits enemy vehicle PAKTIA, July 18 – At least three policemen were killed and two others wounded when a roadside bomb attack struck and destroyed their vehicle in Ahmad Khail district of Paktia province last night. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Firefight leaves 2 US-led invaders dead, 3 wounded LOGAR, July 18 – Two Nato invading troops were killed and three others wounded in a gunfight with Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate in Baraki Barak district of Logar province on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

4 puppets killed in bomb explosion in Ghazni GHAZNI, July 18 – A roadside bomb attack Wednesday tore through the puppets while on foot patrol, killing and wounding four minions in Rashidan district, Ghazni province. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

6 policemen killed in bomb attack in Paktia PAKTIA, July 18 – At least 6 policemen were killed in a bomb attack targeting their vehicle in the capital of Paktia province on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Police headquarter comes under missile attack LOGAR, July 18 – Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate attacked the police headquarter with missiles Wednesday afternoon. Two

missile rounds hit the facility, but it is unclear if anyone was killed or wounded. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Four puppets switch sides to join Mujahideen JAUZJAN, July 18 – Four puppet soldiers of hireling army joined Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate with their weapons Wednesday in Khanaqa district of Juzjan province. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

5 US-NATO invaders killed in bombings KHOST, July 18 – At least five invading terrorists were killed and another wounded with one of their armored personnel carriers destroyed in separate bomb attacks in Sabri district of Khost province on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

11 minions taken down, 4 wounded in clashes WARDAK, July 18 – Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate clashed with the puppets in Nirkh district of Wardak province later on Wednesday, leaving 3 policemen dead.

Shortly afterwards extra enemy forces were called in to fend off Mujahideen attack in which a further 8 policemen were killed and 4 others wounded and a vehicle of the enemy was destroyed after shooting by Mujahideen with rockets, whereas one Mujahid got martyred with two others wounded during the clashes. Bombings kills 6 puppets, injure 4 others KHOST, July 18 – Some 6 policemen were killed and 4 got wounded with their vehicle destroyed in two separate bomb attacks in Musa Khel district of Khost province on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

3 killed, 3 injured in bomb blast in Logar LOGAR, July 18 – A remotely detonated bomb blast in the capital of Logar province struck the enemy armored tank late on Wednesday leaving three puppets dead and three others wounded. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

5 puppets killed in gun battle NANGARHAR, July 18 – At least five puppets were killed Wednesday after Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate surprised the enemy in Bati Kot district of Nangarhar province, triggering a half-hour fight. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

District struck with missiles in Wardak WARDAK, July 18 – The district of Jalga in Wardak province came under Mujahideen attack later on Wednesday, but no losses of life and injury are determined yet. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Enemy base comes under heavy arms fire in Nangarhar NANGARHAR, July 18 – The military base of the US terrorist forces in Nazyan district of Nangarhar province came under

heavy arms fire yesterday but no losses of life and injury are reported. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

8 policemen killed in bomb blast in Kunduz KUNDUZ, July 18 – As many as 8 policemen were reported dead Wednesday in powerful bomb blast detonated remotely by Mujahideen through remote-controlled device targeting the enemy ranger vehicle in Imam Sahab district of Kunduz province. Dozens of puppets killed in clashes in Paktia PAKTIA, July 18 – Scores of the puppets were killed and wounded in clashes with Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate in Jani Khel district of Paktia province on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Bomb kills one enemy soldier, injures three more PAKTIKA, July 18 – A bomb explosion in Paktika province's Sarhawza district left one puppet dead and three others wounded on Wednesday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Mujahideen dismantled Arbakis' safe haven KUNDUZ, July 18 – Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate attacked the outpost of the Arbakis in Dashti Archi district of Kunduz province, and after a firefight of hours dismantled the post completely. Mujahideen also captured 1 motorcycle, 5 body armors and ammunition. An Arbaki was fatally shot during the exchange of fire. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Mujahideen attack post, kills 2 minions in Kabul KABUL, July 18 – The Islamic Emirate's Mujahideen fired missiles into the enemy sanctuary based in Sarubi district of Kabul province last night, killing two puppet soldiers. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Mujahideen kill 2 policemen, injure 5 in Panjsher PANJSHER, July 18 - Mula Khairullah, heading a group of Mujahideen during a clash yesterday in the center of Paryan district of Panjshir province yesterday fell into hands of the enemy, whereas as two policemen were killed and three others wounded by Mujahideen in the firefight. Later during the night, Mujahideen attacked the jail where Mula Khairullah was detained, sparking yet another clash that ended in wounding a further two police and the release of the mentioned Mujahid from the jail who joined Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate safely. Mujahideen conquer district in Ghazni GHAZNI, July 18 - The district of Rashidan which was in the hands of Mujahideen except for the district headquarter or center of the district came completely under Mujahideen control yesterday after Mujahideen forced the enemy out of the district center and raised their white flag.

The center of the district had been under Mujahideen siege and constant attacks for the past few months that put the enemy in panic and terror and last night the enemy, in a great hurry, burned down what they could burn such as their arms and military vehicles and gears leaving the rest behind and got away from the district headquarter of Rashidan. Infamous Arbaki spy agent dies after succumbing to injuries PARWAN, July 18 -

Zamarai, a US spy and the head of Arbakis in Charikar city, the capital of Parwan province was fatally wounded in a guerrilla attack by Mujahideen in the mentioned city yesterday who taken to the hospital where he could not stand the bullet wounds and died succumbing to injuries in the evening hours of the day.

The target, a wicked and cruel Arbaki coming from Shinwari district of this province, is reported to have been involved in a series of crimes such as tortures, murders harassment and after the martyrdom of some civilians and Mujahideen at his hand, he fled to Charikar city, where Basir Salangi, the governor appointed him as the head of Arbakis Charikar.

As a result, he faced the music yesterday as what goes around comes back around. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

5 policemen killed in attack on post KUNDUZ, July 18 – At least five policemen were killed Thursday morning when Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate attacked their check post in the capital of Kunduz province. Mujahideen also captured four Kalashnikov rifles and 1 automatic machine gun. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Mortar shells hit outpost in Paktia PAKTIA, July 18 – Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate Tuesday attacked the enemy outpost using mortar shells in Patan district of Paktia province early Thursday morning, a repost indicates without providing any casualty details. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Enemy base comes under heavy arms fire in Kunar KUNAR, July 18 – The military base of the US terrorist forces in Watapur district of Kunar province came under heavy arms fire Thursday but no losses of life and injury are reported. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

4 US-Nato invaders killed in bomb blast in LOGAR, July 18 –At four invaders were reported dead Thursday in bomb blast setting off under the enemy armored tanks in Baraki Barak district of Kunduz province. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Arbaki shot, killed by sniper KUNDUZ, July 18 – An Arbaki puppet was shot dead in a sniper attack by a Mujahideen in Chahar Darah district of Kunduz province on Thursday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Five minions surrender in Nangarhar NANGARHAR, July 18 – A report says that five puppets of ANA joined Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate in Hisarak district of Nangarhar province on Thursday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Bomb kills five invaders in Logar LOGAR, July 18 – A roadside bomb blast killed four invading terrorist as it went off under their armored personnel carrier in Baraki Bark district of Logar province on Thursday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Dozens of Arbaki puppets killed in clashes in Kunar KUNAR, July 18 – Scores of the Arbaki puppets were killed and wounded in clashes with Mujahideen of the Islamic Emirate in Chowki district of Kunar province on Thursday. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

2 civilians injured as enemy mortar shell slams into compound KUNDUZ, July 18 – A report indicates that the enemy mortar shelling struck one of the civilian's home in Dashti Archi district of Kunduz province last night, leaving two civilians severely wounded. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Puppets patrol falls into ambush in Wardak WARDAK, July 18 – A dozen of the puppets were killed and wounded Thursday when their patrol walked into Mujahideen ambush in the capital of Wardak province. Reported by Zabihullah Mujahid

Shrapnel IED kills 2 puppets in Qalat ZABUL, Jul. 18 – A shrapnel packed IED placed in Zarha Nawrak area adjacent Qalat city detonated on the foot patrol of hireling troops Wednesday noon, instantly killing 2 gunmen on the spot. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Cowardly invaders abduct 3 civilians in night raid HELMAND, Jul. 18 – Reports from Marjah district say that cowardly foreign invaders carried out a raid on Sefan area at 02:00 am local time today during which they abducted 3 civilians before leaving the area. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Nawbahar district HQ comes under armed attack ZABUL, Jul. 18 – Enemy forces suffered deadly losses 03:00 pm yesterday when Mujahideen carried out a heavy and light arms attack on Nawbahar district headquarters. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Mine blast leaves 2 Arbaki gunmen dead HELMAND, Jul. 18 – 2 hireling Arbaki gunmen died following a mine blast which blew apart their motorbike 11:00 am Wednesday in Musa Kala district's Landi Nawa area. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

4 hirelings killed and wounded in ambush on patrol ZABUL, Jul. 18 – 4 hireling troops were killed and wounded yesterday at around 03:00 pm when Mujahideen ambushed their foot patrol near the compound of Abdul Ghani adjacent Nawbahar district center. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Heavy fighting ongoing in Nawzad HELMAND, Jul. 18 – Reports arriving from Nawzad district say that Mujahideen engaged foreign invaders and their hirelings that were airdropped by helicopters early this morning in Tangyano Karez and Baghki Karez areas, sparking heavy clashes which forced the enemy to flee from Tangyano Karez area however the fight is still being contested in Baghki Karez area.

The enemy has suffered deadly losses in the fighting, more details about which will be updated as information arrives. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

2 gunmen killed as IED detonates on patrol HELMAND, Jul. 18 – An IED placed in Babaji Faqir area of Sarwan Kala region, Sangin district, detonated on the foot patrol of hireling troops 10:00 pm last night as a result, 2 gunmen were killed on the spot while another was severely wounded. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Check post attacked in Panjwaee, 2 killed KANDAHAR, Jul. 18 – An Arbaki check post located in Zangawat region's Mar Kala area, Sangin, was pounded with several 82mm artillery rounds later yesterday afternoon time as a result, 2 gunmen in the watchtower were killed. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

2 puppets killed in attack on security post HERAT, Jul. 18 – Mujahideen of Islamic Emirate carried out a heavy and light arms attack midnight on Surabyano check post located near Rabat-e-Sangi district center during which 2 enemy personnel were killed and 3 others wounded whereas 2 Mujahideen were also injured by enemy fire in the operation. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Ghormach blast kills hireling trooper BADGHIS, Jul. 18 – A bomb detonated on dismounted police near an ISAF base in Do Aabi area of Ghormach district this morning at 05:00 am local time, instantly killing 1 hireling gunman on the spot. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

3 puppets killed in attack on check posts HELMAND, Jul. 18 – Mujahideen of Islamic Emirate carried out a coordinated armed assault on several enemy check posts located between Loe Manda and Spin Masjid areas of Babaji district from 06:30 am till 09:00 am this morning as a result, 3 puppets were killed and several others wounded besides the enemy suffering damages. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Rifle and motorbike seized from Arbaki gunman URUZGAN, Jul. 18 – At around 12:00 pm today, Mujahideen seized the rifle and motorbike of a hireling Arbaki gunman in a tactical attack in Dehrawod district's Shingholi area. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Double IED attack leaves 4 hirelings dead, 3 wounded HELMAND, Jul. 18 – Mujahideen detonated a bomb on the foot patrol of hireling troops this morning at 08:00 am in Ainak area of Nawa district following with another IED strike on the evacuation team as a result, a total of 4 gunmen were killed and 3 others severely wounded. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

2 ANA puppets shot dead by sniper fire KANDAHAR, Jul. 18 – 2 hireling ANA troopers standing inside Maktab check post in Talokan area of Panjwaee district were shot dead by a Mujahid sniper this morning. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Landmine blows apart US-nato tank in Maiwand KANDAHAR, Jul. 18 – A landmine placed in Kala Shamir region's Shil Ghami Manda area, Maiwand district, blew apart a US-nato tank on Wednesday midday, killing and wounding all invaders aboard however their exact numbers could not be determined. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

Hand grenades hurled inside check post, 2 police killed HELMAND, Jul. 18 – 2 hireling police were killed and another wounded when Mujahideen hurled several hand grenades inside their check post, located in Bolan area near Lashkargah city, later yesterday afternoon time at around 06:00 pm. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

2 militiamen killed in Panjwaee KANDAHAR, Jul. 18 – Mujahideen opened fire on hireling Arbakis manning a search point near Mooshan bridge of Panjwaee district 01:00 pm Wednesday, killing 2 puppets on the spot before safely leaving the area and reaching their bases. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

8 enemy troops killed in Sangin, 6 wounded HELMAND, Jul. 18 – Officials reporting from Sangin district say that heavy fighting broke out 09:00 am and lasted till 04:00 pm local time when Mujahideen engaged combined foreign and hireling troops that came out to multiple areas of Sarwan Kala region.

It is said that 5 IEDs also detonated on the enemy during the battle while another IED blew apart an ANA tank, leaving a total of 8 enemy personnel dead and a further 6 wounded. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi

ANA post attacked in Sangin HELMAND, Jul. 18 – An ANA check post located in Khanano village of Sangin district was initially hit by Mujahideen with a missile following it up with a

heavy and light arms attack today at 11:00 am in the morning, likely to have caused the enemy dead losses however its exact extent is not clear. Reported by Qari Yousuf Ahmadi
