

## Game operator Roots is currently licensed to provide virtual slot machines in Germany

The company announced this in a press release last week. However, the operator has not yet been whitelisted by the Saxony-Anhalt State Administration Office, which updated on Sept. 23. Rootz Ltd. was one of the first Malta-based game providers to receive a German license for virtual slot machines. The company therefore meets Germany's legal and secure online gambling requirements, which meet all technical requirements for the protection of minors and players.

A relatively young company has succeeded in making a leap into a regulated online gambling market in Germany. Rootz Ltd. was founded in 2018 and claims to access online games through a "quality over quantity" approach. <u>비카라사이트</u>

Market entry in Germany should have been planned for a long time, but it has already reported in January this year that it has passed the ISO 27001 audit required by German regulators, which specifies the requirements that gambling providers must meet in terms of information management systems.

By passing this audit, we have achieved our first milestone on the way to a German license. It was preceded by months of efforts to ultimately meet stringent regulatory requirements. According to Rootz, the workload invested was significant. However, the provider hopes to consolidate its position on the international stage with a German license and serve as an important player here.
