



## 20+ Last Names that Mean Protector: Strength, Bravery, and Protection

**Porter** - Often referred to doormen, gate-keepers or other entrance wardens at fortifications, towns and manors.

Shields - Self-explanatory reference to the physical protection of shields in battle or while on patrol.
