

Origin of Statuario Marble

Statuario marble is sourced from Carrara, Italy. It is a pure white stone with grey veins running over the surface. Because of its timeless elegance and natural beauty, customers pick Statuario marble for their entryways, living areas, worktops, and bathrooms. These aesthetic elements can brighten the room in any home or business.

How to Clean the Statuario Marble:



Marble floors should be cleaned on a regular basis, and surfaces should be wiped with a soft cotton towel.

Statuario marble is a high-end stone that should be cleaned with extreme caution. On your marble surfaces. Instead, use water and a small amount of a neutral, mild detergent, such as dish detergent or a stone-specific soap.

To avoid water stains, it is necessary to dry marble surfaces with a soft towel after washing. Never allow surface water on marble surfaces.

How to Polish your Statuario Marble:

Marble polishing is essential for its lifespan and beauty. Polishing marble surfaces preserves them by minimizing the chance of stain absorption. Polishing also keeps surfaces bright and visually appealing.

There are cleaning powders that can be used on marble surfaces, but the results are not nearly as protective, appealing, or effective as professional services.

Polishing marble properly needs experience and specialised equipment. Attempting to clean marble at home could cause serious and costly harm to your surfaces. This is due to the fact that polishing the surfaces too much or too little is equally damaging.

Caring for Statuario Marble Surfaces



- Never use cleansers with acidic components.
- To clean marble surfaces, never use abrasive cleaning products such as sponges or brushes.
- Never drench the floor with a wet mop since it will trap water in the marble's surfaces.
- All commercial cleansers should be avoided. These will eat the marble's surface.
- Avoid contacting marble surfaces with oil or wax products. These will be absorbed by marble, resulting in discoloration.
- Never leave marble unprotected; doing so significantly increases its susceptibility to damage.
- Drag boxes, tables, or large furniture across marble flooring.
- Spills should be cleaned up as soon as they occur. The marble will immediately absorb liquid.
- Use cleaners designed exclusively for real stone, particularly marble.
- Professionals should be contacted to polish your marble surfaces.
- Because marble is a porous material, it is prone to stains. Because of its white tone,
 Statuario marble is very vulnerable. The stone's construction may also get broken or suffer other unintended damage.

• These things do happen, despite our best attempts to preserve our surfaces. When they do, it is critical that they contact a natural stone contractor.

Statuario Quartz:





Statuario Premium Quartz




<u>Statuario Premium</u> is highly successful at imitating true Statuario marble, but without the flaws that natural marble possesses, it is less expensive than the real thing.


• Statuario Tigris Quartz
