



## Eliana Name Meaning in Bible: Who She Was and What It Signifies? – Imp

Eliana is a female name meaning "God has answered" or "God replied", both in reference to the devotion and prayers of Hannah who wished for a child from God in the Bible. The name Eliana originated from the Hebrew name Eliana or Eliana, which is related to the name Elinor or Eleanor.

When presenting Samuel at the tabernacle, Hannah explained to Eli the priest: "For this child I prayed; and the Lord hath given me my petition which I asked of him: Therefore also I have lent him to the Lord; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the Lord." The name Eliana acknowledges God answering prayer, just as He answered Hannah's prayers by giving her Samuel.
