

**Kitchen Countertops with Steel Grey Granite** 



Quarried from and processed at granite industries in India, the amazing visible characteristics of this stone, especially on being finished and processed by stone experts makes it impressive for interior as well as exterior building projects. Features like low variation and high durability make it even more suitable for incorporating as <u>kitchen worktops</u> since high resistance to wear and tear is among the top priorities in a busy space like a cookhouse. As hinted earlier, this particular granite can be found in different types of finishings: polished granite, sandblasted, sandblasted + brushed, bush-hammered, bush hammered + brushed, honed granite, and leather finish. One can create a calm and composed environment in their cooking and dining space with this neutral color that gives a new meaning to style with minute specks of lighter greys scattered over the surface of granite stone.

**Grey Stone Worktop With William Quartz** 



This is a light grey quartz stone that shows the presence of minute splashes of black as well as darkish grey stripes that keep moving randomly in repetitive behavior. This material is not just limited to kitchen worktops but can also be chosen for various other purposes within and outside it. They can be used as kitchen countertops, backsplashes, kitchen windowsills, wall capping, water fountains, floorings, etc. This might have given a hint already that it can be used for interior as well as exterior applications according to the necessity of the situation.

You might know that <u>quartz worktops</u> are made of engineered stone, manufactured in industries to be used for various projects mentioned previously. So, they are infused with physical and chemical properties like durability, heat resistance, stain resistance, scratch resistance etc to make them one of the best kitchen countertops materials. Even from a materialistic point of view, they come in a vast range of colors. This means that inside the grey choice, you will further have several shades of it to choose from. As a kitchen is exposed to harsh conditions daily like the use of knives, citric acid spills, fruit and vegetables liquids, cleaning agents, hot pans, knives and forks and all the messy handlings, qualities like the ones mentioned above, become priorities while investing on a remodeling or new setup. Sealing is already included in the manufacturing process, so it will not be required during its installation. The benefits of proper sealing are limitless. In fact, it is due to this that major other problems that arise in a kitchen are checked. It doesn't allow water and colored products to penetrate

inside the material. This ensures that bacterial and microbial contamination does not occur, which keeps the space hygienic and increases the material's life stage. As a result, maintenance of the space will also be comparatively easy.

Kitchen Countertops- Finishing of Stones

### **Polished Finish:**



The visible color strikes are well highlighted in this category giving the countertops a glossy surface and improving their reflecting capacity by making them appear vibrant.

### **Honed Finish:**



This kind of finish creates the material to appear less shiny and non-reflective. This can be picked up by those homeowners whose kitchens are already based on bright indoor lighting. Another advantage of this is, that the matted nature allows the fingerprints and smudges arising from regular touches to be hidden unlike in a polished finish.

# **Worktop Thickness**

Irrespective of the finishes and stone colours, <u>quartz kitchen worktops</u> can be available in different thicknesses; the popular ones are 20mm quartz worktop and 30mm kitchen countertops.
