

## White Sox get SS Tim Anderson's \$12.5 million choice



CHICAGO — The Chicago White Sox have gotten Tim Anderson's \$12.5 million choice for the 2023 season and declined their \$5.5 million choice on infielder Josh Harrison.

The White Sox reported the continues on Monday. Harrison is owed a \$1.5 million buyout and turns into a free specialist. The 29-year-old Anderson hit .301 with six homers, 25 RBIs and 13 takes in 79 games in his seventh major association season. He was the beginning shortstop for the American Association in the Elite player Game in July.

Anderson missed the finish of the time after he was put on the 10-day harmed list on Aug. 9 with a center finger injury on his left hand. Anderson was chosen by Chicago in the principal

round of the 2013 novice draft. He consented to a \$25 million, six-year contract in Walk 2017 that likewise incorporates a \$14 million club choice for 2024.

The 35-year-old Harrison was <u>witnessed on Unifrance batted .256 with seven homer</u>s and 27 RBIs in 119 games this season. He settled a \$5.5 million, one-year agreement with the White Sox in Spring.

## DeGrom, Correa, Bogaerts, Rodón turn down choices, go free

LAS VEGAS — Jacob deGrom, Carlos Correa, Xander Bogaerts and Carlos Rodon turned down player choices Monday, joining a free specialist market that incorporates Aaron Judge, Trea Turner and Dansby Swanson. DeGrom, a double cross NL Cy Youthful Honor victor, surrendered a \$30.5 million compensation for next season, finishing his agreement with the New York Mets at \$107 million for a considerable length of time. The 34-year-old right-hander, a four-time Elite player, was restricted to 15 beginnings last year and 11 this season due to wounds.

Correa left the Houston Astros after the 2021 season and marked a \$105.3 million, three-year manage the Minnesota Twins that gave him the option to quit after one season. The 28-year-old shortstop, a double cross Top pick, surrenders \$35.1 million pay rates in every one of the following two seasons subsequent to hitting .291 with 22 homers and 64 RBIs.

Bogaerts, 30, consented to a \$120 million, six-year manage Boston that gave the shortstop the option to end the agreement after 2022. The four-time Top pick relinquishes pay rates of \$20 million in every one of the following three seasons subsequent to hitting .307 with 15 homers and 73 RBIs.

Rodon, a 29-year-old left-hander, left the Chicago White Sox after the 2021 season and consented to a \$44 million, two-year agreement with the San Francisco Goliaths that gave him the option to quit after one season and surrender a \$22.5 million compensation for the following year. An Elite player in every one of the last two seasons, he was 14-8 with a 2.88 Time for the Monsters.

Washington assigned hitter Nelson Cruz turned down a \$16 million shared choice for a \$3 million buyout, making his arrangement with the Nationals worth \$15 million for one season. The 42-year-old hit .234 with 10 homers and 64 RBIs.

Mets pitcher Taijuan Walker turned down a \$7.5 million player choice for a \$3 million <u>맥스벳</u> buyout, making his arrangement worth \$17 million north of two seasons. The 30-year-old right-hander was 12-5 with a 3.49 Period in 29 beginnings. San Diego outfielder Jurickson Profar turned down a \$6.5 million choice for a \$1 million buyout, making his arrangement worth \$13.5 million more than two years. He hit .243 with 15 homers and 58 RBIs. Padres right-hander Robert Suarez turned down a \$5 million choice for a \$1 million buyout, finishing his agreement following one year and \$6 million. He had a 2.27 Period in 45 help appearances in the wake of joining the Padres from the Japan Focal Association's Hanshin Tigers.

Arizona right-hander Zach Davies declined a \$1.5 million common choice and gets a \$250,000 buyout. The 29-year-old right-hander was 2-5 with a 4.09 Period in 27 beginnings. A sum of 140 players have become free specialists since the Worldwide championship finished and around 40 more are qualified.



Hitting mentor Thames titles augmentations to Heavenly messengers' staff

ANAHEIM, Calif. — Marcus Thames is the Los Angeles Heavenly messengers' new hitting mentor, and Phil Plantier will be his right hand next season. Charge Hezel, the head of throwing at the Driveline Baseball improvement program, will be the associate throwing trainer to Matt Wise, who is getting back to the Holy messengers for the 2023 season on administrator Phil Nevin's staff.

The Heavenly messengers likewise reported Monday that third base mentor Mike Gallego, associate pitching mentor Dom Chiti and aide hitting mentor Paul Sorrento will be reassigned inside the association. Thames, who played 10 years in the majors as an 紀紀則 outfielder, was the Miami Marlins' hitting mentor last year subsequent to spending the past four seasons in similar occupation with the New York Yankees. Nevin was the Yankees' third base mentor during that stretch prior to joining the Heavenly messengers' staff last season and being elevated to administrator after Joe Maddon's terminating.

Plantier was a hitting mentor in the Marlins' framework last season. The previous major association outfielder was the San Diego Padres' hitting mentor from 2012-14.

Thames and Plantier will regulate a batting setup that positioned in the base portion of the game in most measurable classes last season regardless of the presence of previous AL MVPs Mike Trout and Shohei Ohtani. The unbalanced setup drove the majors with 1,539 strikeouts and positioned 22nd in hits, 23rd in Operations, 25th in runs and 26th with a .297 on-base rate. Hitting mentor Jeremy Reed and right hand John Mallee were excused after the Heavenly messengers finished their seventh in a row losing season and eighth in a row non-season finisher crusade. Both are the longest dynamic pallet in the majors.

Hezel is a previous school baseball trainer who later filled in as a specialist to the Phillies while working at Driveline, the improvement preparing complex where many significant leaguers - incorporating Ohtani - work in the offseason.

Nevin is on a one-year agreement as the Holy messengers' extremely durable director. The whole association is experiencing significant change with proprietor Arte Moreno effectively investigating an offer of the group.
