The durability of hand-knotted rugs depends on their care and usage.

The difference between these two types of rugs largely lies in the method used to make them. A machine-loomed rug is made in a short time using low-quality labor. The second type, on the other hand, is more luxurious and a more durable option. It is available in almost any color, pattern, and texture, while a hand-tufted one requires an elaborate fabrication process.

A major disadvantage of hand-tufted rugs is the odor. The glue and base used to create them cause an unpleasant odor. However, <u>hand-knotted</u> rugs are more expensive but are worth the cost. They are handmade pieces of art, and are therefore more expensive. The advantages of a hand-knotted rug outweigh its drawbacks.

A Hand-knotted rug is more durable than a machine-tufted one. Both types are made from high-quality wool and require highly skilled artisans. They have a coarser feel than a machine-

tufted one. They are also usually reversible. The yarns are either cut or shaved after they have been finished. The knots will be a little uneven and show the working of the human hand. c A hand-tufted rug is made with a mechanized tool that punches strands of wool yarn into a canvas backing. The designer draws the design on the canvas and a needle and thread are then poked into it. Both types of <u>rugs</u> can be placed in high-traffic areas and will add character to any room.
