Arsenal Limassol vs Slovan Bratislava is an intriguing matchup between two long established European clubs. Founded in 1952, Arsenal Limassol is one of the most successful teams in Cyprus with 20 league titles and 15 cups. They will be hoping to qualify for the group stages of UEFA Conference League for the first time in the club's history. Their opponents Slovan Bratislava were formed in 1919 in Czechoslovakia and are the most decorated club in Slovakia with 42 league championships.

Both teams rely heavily on local talent, with Arsenal fielding 10 Cypriot players in their last
match while Slovan started 7 Slovakians. However, Arsenal possess more European
experience in recent years having reached the Europa League group stage in 2015. To
progress, they will need clinical finishes from leading goalscorer Pavol Šafranko in addition to
solid defending from experienced Belgium international Toby Alderweireld □□.
Momentum is with Slovan who are unbeaten in 11 matches including qualifying wins over Irish
side Dundalk. Their front line of Rafael Ratao □□ and Ezekiel Henty caused problems in the
last round and will look to exploit any gaps in Arsenal's backline. In midfield, former Rangers
man Vladimir Weiss □□ is capable of unlocking stubborn opponents with his range of passing
and set pieces.

The two matches are expected to be tightly contested with little to separate the teams on paper. Home advantage may prove crucial as both sets of supporters rally behind their clubs in their quest to reach the financial and prestige bonuses of UEFA Conference League group stage football. Arsenal will hope inspiration from fans at GSP Stadium can carry them over the line, while Slovan believe their incredible support at packed Štadión Pasienky can be their 12th man.
