

What is a Business Administration Course?

Arguably, the best and most common **business administration course** is the MBA.

The MBA (Master of Business Administration) is an academic course in a number of business subjects that together make up the 'science' of management.

In the English-speaking world, the MBA is so highly regarded that many assume it is the only academic business qualification available, which is not the case. For example, in Japan, there are masses of management and business education but no MBA. In mainland Europe most business education generally, and management administration courses, in particular, are at the undergraduate (Bachelor) level. In many countries around the globe, the MBA has no legally recognized status at all. Even in the UK and USA, where the MBA is much heralded, there are a large number and variety of undergraduate business courses.

In addition to undergraduate education, an increasing number of online education providers are filling the gap for UK students who have not been to university. **Business administration courses** are available from the best distance learning colleges, of which Business Qualifications is perhaps the most popular (https://businessqualifications.com). MBA students tend to be older than most undergraduates because they're expected to have a first degree and some work experience. So, MBA students are rarely under 24 years of age, and many are older, even into their 50s.

Apart from a recognized degree, the only entrance exam for the best schools in Europe and the USA Is the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).
