Signs like these may incorporate small air pockets or porosity scattered across the ring, an orange strip like surface fundamentally in the filigree shoulder detail or under-bezel and an absence of high quality precision expected in an antique trilogy ring.

The simplest and fastest method for separating an antique cut and an advanced slice is to see the side profile.
