On Tuesday Therabody started shipping its tally RecoveryAir compression boots moreover a
starting price of \$699 for the base model. The RecoveryAir Pro, which offers full customization
of recovery programs and includes a rotate base station, costs \$1,299. Both base stations
have rechargeable batteries for that reason you can use the systems re the go and the legs
