



Tips on how to install a fence using DIY techniques

To install a wooden fence outside the house, there are stakes that are driven into the ground and perfectly support the structure.

But if we do not want to damage the land, in this bric-a-brac, we are going to give you a very interesting idea.

Step 1

It involves fixing these metal supports to a wooden grid, using a polyurethane adhesive, which, due to its components, acts better with humidity; so it is perfect for outdoor work.

Step 2

We start by cleaning the joining surfaces well with a cloth moistened with alcohol.

Step 3

Next, we apply adhesive to the bottom of the first bracket and stick the part onto the grid.

Step 4

We do the same with the other base and we tie the whole with some clamps, to exert pressure; since this product expands.

Step 5

When the adhesive has dried, we insert the treated wood posts into the metal pieces and fasten them with their corresponding lag screws.

Step 6

We can now fix the fence to the posts using metal brackets.

Step 7

Another advantage of this system is that the fence is mobile, so we can change its location depending on the space we want to delimit, in each case.
