


Lifeguard Training Needs

In Taiwan there are 3 major lifesaving organizations providing lifeguard licenses and also coaching, one is called National Water Life Conserving Organization Republic of China (NWLSAROC) one other is recognized as The Red Cross Culture of the Republic of China and National Chinese Browse Llfe Saving Association(NCSLSA).
