Chinese gadgets creator Xiaomi on Friday declared hierarchical changes in the Indian administration group. Alvin Tse, a Xiaomi Global establishing colleague, POCO establishing part, previous General Manager of Xiaomi Indonesia, will expect the job of General Manager, Xiaomi India, the organization reported.
