

Canada: Immigration Levels Plan 2022-2024

The results have been revealed! Immigrants worldwide will be able to apply for residency in Canada from 2022–2024. Between 2022 and 2024, the Canadian government expects to welcome around 430,000 new immigrants year, the most significant amount in the country's history and roughly 1% of the total population of Canada.

An overview of Canada's immigration plans.

New immigration levels plans are announced each year by Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). Canada plans to welcome the following number of new arrivals between 2022 and 2024:

- 2022: 431,645 permanent residents
- 2023: 447,055 permanent residents
- 2024: 451,000 permanent residents

How Immigrants are Important to Canada's Future

Canada encourages immigration as a means of bolstering its economy. In addition to having one of the world's oldest populations, Canada also has one of the lowest birth rates in the world. This mismatch harms both the economy and the government's finances. Canada has been boosting immigration levels since the late 1980s to increase the nation's economy, population, and labor force to overcome the challenges imposed by a lower birth rate and an aging population. Even though PGWP holders can stay in Canada to work temporarily, it does not guarantee that they will be granted permanent status. Immigration Pathways by Province and Territory

You can learn more about each province and territory's possible migratory paths below.

Alberta (AB)

As part of the Alberta Advantage Immigration Program (AAIP), eligible persons can apply for permanent residency. In general, there are four major streams of activity:

- Alberta Opportunity Stream
- Alberta Express Entry Stream
- International Graduate Entrepreneur Immigration Stream
- Self-Employed Farmer Stream

British Columbia (BC)

To become a permanent resident of British Columbia, qualified foreign workers and businesses can apply for the Provincial Nominee Program (BC PNP).

- To be eligible for the BC PNP, newcomers must apply in one of three ways:
- Skills Immigration
- Express Entry BC
- Entrepreneur Immigration

Manitoba (MB)

Manitoba's Provincial Nominee Program (MPNP) helps educated individuals with skills and business experience get a foothold in the Canadian economy. You may apply by going to the following website:

Skilled Worker Stream

- International Education Stream (IES) for Manitoba Graduates
- · Business Investor Stream

New Brunswick (NB)

The province of New Brunswick has three distinct immigration schemes:

- NBPNP Skilled Worker Stream
- NB Express Entry
- Atlantic Immigration Program

Northwest Territories (NT)

Students, entrepreneurs, and skilled employees who can fill critical roles that cannot be filled locally are eligible for expedited immigration under the Northwest Territories Nomination Program (NTNP). In two directions:

- Employer-Driven Stream
- Business Stream

Ontario (ON)

By proposing highly skilled foreign employees for immigration, the Ontario Provincial Nominee Program (OINP) contributes to Ontario's economy. These are some examples:

- Employer Job Offer Category
- Master's Graduate and Ph.D. Graduate categories
- Human Capital Category
- Entrepreneur Stream

Quebec (QC)

Quebec's immigration initiatives seek to speed up the immigration process for newcomers while also filling job needs in the province.

- · Permanent Workers
- Businesspeople
- Temporary Workers
- Foreign Students
- Family Reunification

Yukon (YT)

To speed up the process of permanent residency for qualified foreign employees, Yukon collaborates with the federal government through the Yukon Nominee Program. If a job opportunity is not filled locally, the company might then offer the position to a qualified foreign

national. Newcomers can't enter the country via the YNP unless they first get a work offer. A total of three YNP tracks are available:

- Skilled Worker Program
- Critical Impact Worker Program

Yukon Express Entry
