The frame is joined with different parts combined to make a frame that can stand usage for over 30 years. The fabrics of folding arm awnings generally do not last for more than 10 to 15 years and have to be replaced after that.

Places where folding arm awnings are used

<u>Folding arm awnings in Sunshine Coast</u> are used in outdoor areas of the properties. These can be attached to the property or stand-alone creating an area of shade and shelter where people relax and do activities they love to do. Folding arm awnings are not only used in residential properties, even commercial properties like hotels, resorts, and shops install folding arm awnings. Stores and shops install folding arm awnings in the front areas so that the goods

kept inside the windows get shade. Fabrics of the folding arm awnings over storefronts can have attractive graphics and logos printed meant to attract passing customers.
