The Indravati National Park (INP) is situated in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur region and ranges a space of around 2799.08 km2. It is home to one of the last wild bison populaces on the planet. The vegetation of the Indravati National Park is for the most part tropical soggy and dry deciduous, with sal, teak, and bamboo trees overwhelming. Tigers, panthers, Indian buffalo, nilgai, blackbuck, chausingha, sambar, chital, Indian muntjac, Indian spotted chevrotain, and different creatures live there.

## MORE ABOUT INDRAVATI NATIONAL PARK

Indravati National Park is a staggering area in the territory of Chhattisgarh's Bijapur region. Kutru National Park is one more name for Indravati National Park.

The Indravati River, which runs along the recreation center's northern limit, gives the recreation center its name. Indravati National Park is Chhattisgarh's generally wonderful and notable untamed life park and tiger hold.

Indravati was set up as a public park in 1981. The recreation center's complete region is around 2799.08 km2 (1258.37 Km2 center region and 1540.71 Km2 support region). Indravati National Park was assigned as a Tiger Reserve under Project Tiger of India in 1983.

The recreation center is known for its assorted untamed life and bird species, which incorporate a portion of the world's most imperiled species like Wild Buffalos and Hill Mynas.

This public park is a nature sweetheart's heaven, with a progression of wonderful slope ranges, lavish green vegetation, and novel untamed life and avifauna.

Birds like gulls, terns, snake peaked hawks, ospreys, wood



pigeons, and different species can be found in the open spaces of the recreation center. Topography

The Park's geology is a principally undulating uneven landscape with heights going from 177 to 599 meters above ocean level.

The recreation center has thickly forested terrains, with creepers and clean securing the recreation center's open spaces. The recreation center additionally has tropical blossoms with lively shadings developing on it.

Southern dry blended deciduous backwoods and southern damp blended deciduous timberlands are the two woods types.
