Make sure you check with your van rental company to see if they allow you to drive their van. Van hire companies in New Zealand typically require that you are 21 years old or older. You must be 21 to drive the van. There are no age restrictions.

Discuss with your company the exclusions and inclusions. Make sure it is equipped with the necessary tools to fit a baby-sitting device. Make sure you confirm in advance how many people will be traveling with you and check if your van can accommodate them all. Are there ferry crossing facilities? There are offices on both the North and South Islands of some companies. It is best to load up your car and take it on the ferry. Then, you can drive off when you reach the other side.
