

Japan To Resume Visa-Free Entry For Individual Travellers On October 11

Tokyo [Japan]: Japan will resume visa-loose access for character travellers on October eleven, Prime Minister Fumio Kishida introduced Thursday in New York, media reports said.

For the first time in about two and a half years, Japan sets out border guidelines near prepandemic norms, suggesting Nikkei Asia. "We will do away with the cap on the number of humans entering the country and could resume accepting the individual tour and visa-free journeys," Kishida said. In an attempt to manipulate the spread of COVID-19, Japan currently simplest permits bundle excursions and requires visas for all visitors together with a cap of 50,000 on everyday arrivals.

However, due to those curbs, Japan's economic system is not able to be fully reopened to travellers. Now, starting October eleven, brief-term visitors will not be required to apply for vacationer visas. Read More...
