

Thinner Top Tiles are often used on walls than on floors and work surfaces, as floors require more durable surfaces to resist the impacts of heavy traffic. 
Based upon the purpose behind use; whether it is flooring, walls, interiors, or bathrooms, they are of different types. Some popular ones have been mentioned briefly under

Ceramic Tiles:




- They are the most common types of tiling customers prefer for flooring. They are made from silica and clay which are made hard at high temperatures. There are two sorts of tile designs in ceramic which are known as Glazed tiles and Quarry Tiles.
- Glazed ones exhibit a glaze coating, which is added after firing ceramic tiles to obtain several colours and textures. They are available in good styles and multiple colours when compared to Quarry tiles and also offer stain and waterproof qualities.
- Quarry tiles are unglazed ones that are mostly used in parking lots and footpaths due to their roughness and anti-skid property. They are available in red, grey, and brown colours and can be found in square, rectangle, and hexagon shapes.




Porcelain Tiles:




They are manufactured by using finely grained clay at higher temperatures compared to ceramic tiles. They are more compact, tougher, and better at absorbing moisture than ceramic ones. They can be available in all finishes which makes them able to be used for both indoor

and outdoor installations. Due to these wide applications and benefits, they are comparatively costlier.



Vitrified Tiles:



They are obtained by the process of Vitrification. They contain clay and silica materials and are sturdier than ceramic tiles. They have a low water absorption rate as a result of which they can remain intact, thus preventing wear and tear.

They can be found in various further types like Glazed vitrified tiles, Porcelain vitrified tiles, and double charge vitrified tiles. These are different from one another in terms of thickness, style, and colour.

Glass Tiles:



They are manufactured by use of sand and recycled glass, which makes them eco-friendly. These tile designs are mainly used for aesthetic purposes like decorating walls in the living room, but can also be applicable in the kitchen and bathrooms. They can make the room brighter by their reflecting properties. The advantages of these tiles are that they do not fade with the passage of time and remain free from stains as they can easily be cleaned. Carrera Marble Tiles:





Disadvantages:


As with all tiles, there always lies a risk of fissures and ruptures. Though ceramic as well as porcelain are hard wearing and made to withstand areas with heavy traffic, when used on a work surface, they come at risk from heavy-duty kitchenware. Mishandling and dropping iron pots and pans could leave you with unwanted damage on your worktop.

Porcelain is the more durable of the two, and if cracks pertain, you can replace them at a lesser cost.

Top Tiles Maintenance and Care:



- Vacuum and use a fluffy dust mop on a daily basis so as to not allow the dirt to get embedded on your slabs and grouts. Avoid using straw brooms to avoid stains from scratches
- Weekly floor mopping with warm water and a mild soap will maintain the colour and gloss.
- To prevent accidents as well as dirt settling into the mopped area, immediate drying is mandatory
- Do not allow spills to settle, rather use absorbent clothes for a quick wipe, followed by a proper wipe using neutral cleaners and disinfectants
- Prevent mud or water from imprinting on your floor by placing doormats on the entrances and exits. Use bath mats if you have floor tiling in the bathroom to keep them dry.
- Tiles are comparatively much cheaper to maintain than natural stones. With a regular cleaning schedule, your tile flooring will keep looking new for a long time.
