

Saskatchewan Invites 677 Candidates In Recent Saskatchewan PNP Draw Held On 6 July

The Express Entry draw for the SINP took place in Saskatchewan on July 6, 2022, and 398 applicants for in-demand occupations were invited to apply.

Beginning on July 6, 2022, the <u>Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP)</u> will accept applications through two of its immigration streams. 279 of those invited qualified for the <u>SINP's Occupations In-Demand</u> subcategory, while 398 qualified for the subcategory for Express Entry.

On the Expression of Interest (EOI) grading scale, the Saskatchewan applicant who achieved the lowest score in each subcategory received 73 points.

Candidates in both categories were also required to submit Educational Credential Assessments to demonstrate that their foreign education met Canadian requirements.

The federal Express Entry system is integrated with the enhanced **Provincial Nominee Program (PNP)**, which is what Express Entry is a subcategory of.

The Federal Skilled Worker Program, the Federal Skilled Trades Program, and the Canadian Experience Class are three of the most significant economic-class immigration programs in Canada that are controlled by Express Entry.

Candidates with Express Entry profiles must additionally create EOI profiles for Saskatchewan in order to be eligible to receive an invitation to submit an application for a provincial nomination.

Candidates for <u>Canada Express Entry</u> are given an additional 600 points toward their CRS score if they receive a provincial nomination from Saskatchewan. Thanks to this reward, they now have the chance to apply for permanent residence in Canada.

Regarding the subcategory In-Demand Jobs

The **Canada Occupations In-Demand** subcategory is open to immigrants who do not have Express Entry profiles as a base PNP.

See this area if you are looking for highly qualified workers with experience in a Saskatchewan-demanded field who do not yet have a job offer from the government.

To apply for <u>Canadian immigration</u> through this subcategory, foreign nationals must create an EOI profile via the SINP's online application system.

The Saskatchewan EOI system gives the province the ability to select immigrants who have the potential to succeed in the prairie province. Candidates will be evaluated based on their career history, education, language proficiency, age, and ties to the area in order to determine how well they can integrate into Saskatchewan.
