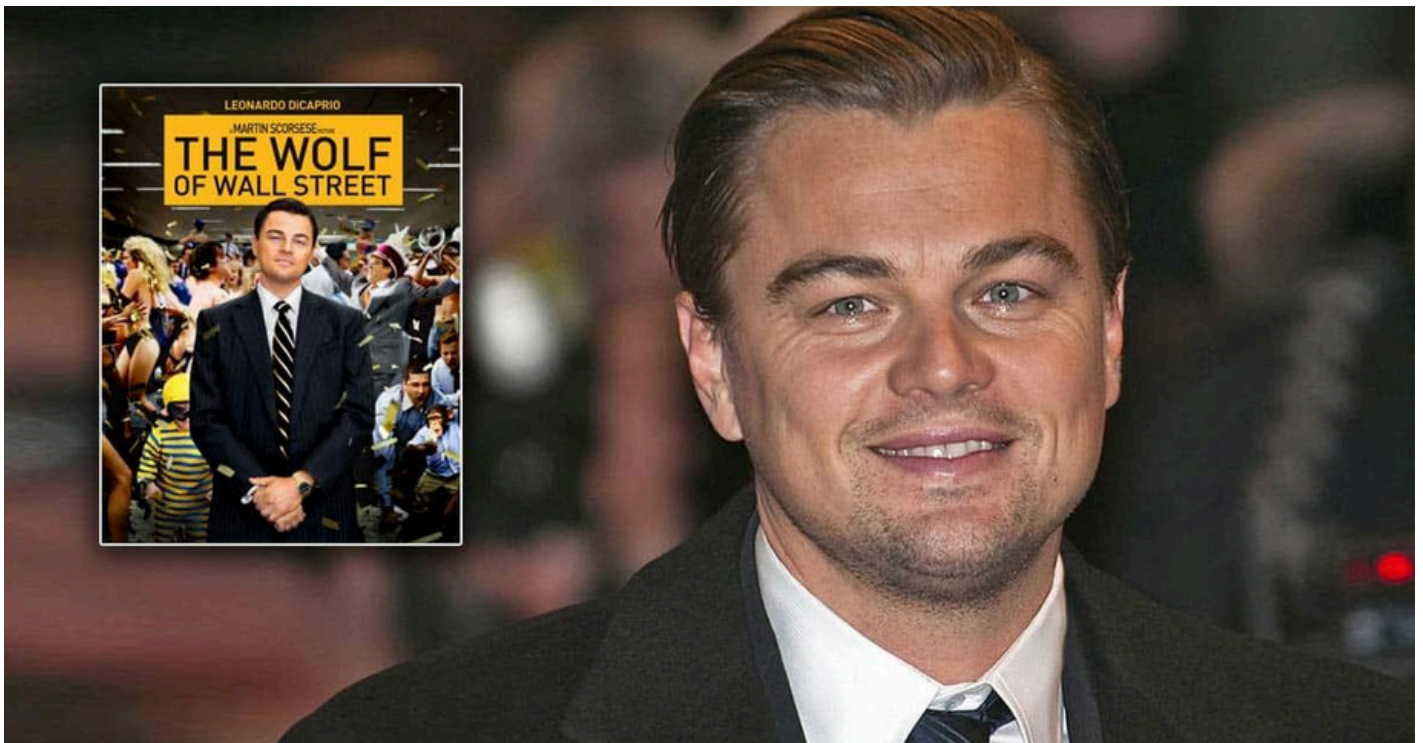




## Did You Know? Leonardo DiCaprio Watched The 'Drunkest Guy In The World' Video
