Ovarian Stimulation

Monitoring

Blood tests and ultrasounds are used to track the development of the eggs and to closely monitor the patient's reaction to the hormones. As the eggs reach maturity, they are harvested by a surgical process known as egg retrieval (aspiration).

Fertilization

Sperm is used to fertilize the eggs in a lab. Intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) is a treatment option for male infertility.

Embryo Culture

To guarantee appropriate development, the fertilized eggs are monitored for a few days, usually three to five.

Embryo Transfer

One or more viable embryos are chosen and placed inside the woman's uterus, where they may implant and result in pregnancy.

Pregnancy Test

To ascertain whether the procedure was successful, a pregnancy test is performed approximately two weeks following the embryo transfer.
