

How to Get Ready for the Varamahalakshmi Festival at Home

"Vara" means "blessing," and "Mahalakshmi" is the Hindu goddess of wealth and prosperity.
"Vrata" refers to fasting.

This fast is performed by married women in order to please the Goddess Lakshmi and receive a boon of money and well-being for the family, particularly the husbands. Women keep the fast until the puja is finished.

adoring Lakshmi on this day is considered to be equivalent to adoring Lakshmi in all of her incarnations. Varamahalakshmi is celebrated on the Friday before a full moon in the Hindu month of Shrayan.

All preparations are made to commemorate this day in spectacular style, and all family members, particularly the women, participate actively in the celebration of this festival. There is no difficulty for individuals who have elders at home, but many people who live away from their home and family in different cities require minimal religious leadership.

If you're one of them, keep reading. The first and most important step is to prepare your home for Varamahalakshmi. Once this is completed, you are ready to begin the pooja. Want to get more ideas to how to <u>decorate varalakshmi puja at home</u> check hear Cleanliness: We all strive to keep our homes clean, but it is especially necessary before a festival. Varamahalakshi Vrata has a special place in her heart for married women. Lakshmi has been invited to enter the house, thus it must be spotless.

Purchase and List:

You cannot afford to go to the market at the last minute. So prepare a list of everything you'll need.. This will contain all of the materials needed for the pooja as well as all of the supplies needed to cook the festive meals. The pooja thread, the kalash (if you don't have one), dry fruits, coconut, flowers, banana leaves, and mango leaves are all important.

List & Purchase: You cannot afford to rush to the market at the last minute. Make a list of all the items you'll need. . This will contain all of the materials needed for the pooja as well as all

of the supplies needed to cook the festive meals. The pooja thread, the kalash (if you don't have one), dry fruits, coconut, flowers, banana leaves, and mango leaves are all important.

Prepare Sweets: Prepare sweets and prasadam to offer to the Goddess. Rava pulihora, nuvvulu appalu, payasam, pesara garelu, and other savoury dishes are served for Varamahalakshmi. When preparing your home for Varamahalakshmi, be sure to prepare sweets a day ahead of time, as you may have a lot on your plate on the day of the vrata.

Decorate: Getting your house ready for Varamahalakshmi entails adorning your home in preparation for the Goddess to arrive and bestow pleasure and fortune on your family. Draw little patterns at the feet of all the doors using rice paste to guide the Goddess. The rangoli that is made on the pedestal on which the Goddess will be put is an important aspect of the decorating. This rangoli must include a lotus flower with eight petals. You know how to prepare your home for Varamahalakshmi Vrata, but you should also know how to prepare the location where the pooja will be performed.

Kalash:

Prepare the kalash with five varieties of fruits, rice, dried fruits, mango leaves, a coconut on top, and cloth before beginning the ceremonies.

Decorate the Shrine:

Dress Goddess Lakshmi with jewellery and fresh garments and place her on the wooden pedestal with the lotus rangoli. Garlands for the Goddess can be made out of cotton and haldi-kumkum. Prepare flower garlands to gift to the Goddess as well.

Prasadam:

All of the prasadam that you have prepared is for the Goddess. It is critical to make an offering of the prasadam, as this is what gives it its meaning. Cover the entire space in banana leaves and flowers. And don't forget to dress nicely, since the Goddess would like you to look your best as well. If you do the rituals with devotion, the Goddess will surely bless you. The southern states of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu celebrate Varamahalakshmi vrata. This vrata is also widely observed in portions of Maharashtra and Orissa.
