Cons of Sandstone Countertops:

Porosity:

Regular Sealing:



Sandstone should be sealed once or twice a year with an impregnating sealer. Many homeowners also prefer to use a topical cleaner/sealant on a weekly basis to ensure that their countertops are completely protected.

Scratches:
