How the Federal Reserve Subsidizes Mexican Drug and Trafficking Cartels

Under the 2005 program, **Directo a México**, the Federal Reserve (FED) facilitated cash transfers (remittance payments) amounting to over \$33 Billion from **illegal aliens** to Mexico in 2018, alone.

Since Illegals cannot lawfully work in the US, many resort to fraud, prostitution, drug trafficking and other criminal activity. Illegals working in the organized crime drug trade (ie MS13) succeed in sending millions of US dollars to Mexico to fund and perpetuate illegal drug sales in the US.

Since there is no requirement for proof of citizenship the Federal Reserve's transfer of US dollars to Mexico effectively subsidizes illegal trade in drugs, human trafficking and other illegal activity.

Furthermore, US dollars gained by illegal aliens steals the wealth of US citizens by avoiding IRS taxes and adding to the financial burden of the US healthcare and judicial systems.

Directo a México is a program launched in 2005 and operated by the <u>Federal Reserve</u> and <u>Banco de Mexico</u>, the <u>central banks</u> of the <u>United States</u> and <u>Mexico</u>, respectively. The program allows <u>commercial banks</u> and <u>credit unions</u> in the U.S. to transfer money through <u>FedACH</u>, the Federal Reserve's <u>clearinghouse</u>, which is linked to **Banco de Mexico**.
