Arizona casinos are found in the 'area of the sun,' in the Southwestern part of the United States. Harrah's Phoenix Ak-Chin Casino Resort, in Maricopa, is available 24-hours and has 40,000 square feet of gaming space, with 950 slots, and ten dining table games. Casino Arizona, in Scottsdale, is available 24-hours, with 30,000 square feet, 500 slots, and 36 table games; and the Paradise Casino, in Yuma, has 1-5 table games, 750 slots, and 30,000 square feet.

The biggest of the Arizona casinos, Casino Del Sol, is located in Tucson and is open 24-hours. That 240,000 square foot casino has 1000 slots, 2-0 table games, and six restaurants. Another one of the bigger Arizona casinos will be the Desert Diamond Casino in Sahurita, with 185,000 square-feet of 15 table games, gambling region, 498 slots, and four restaurants. The Desert Diamond Casino is open Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and 24 hours o-n Saturday and Sunday. There are several other significant Arizona casinos, such as the Cliff Castle Casino in Camp Verde, with 140,000 square feet, 575 slots, and ten table games; and the Gila River Casino - Vee Quiva in Laveen, with 89,000 square feet, 675 slots, and ten table games.

Additionally, the Blue Water Resort and Casino to the Colorado River in Parker, Arizona, offers

slots and poker, as well as blackjack, bingo, and keno. Among the most popular Arizona casinos will be the Fort McDowell Casino in Fountain Hills, with 24-hour tableside food-service, everyday no-limit poker tournaments, and the best poker jackpots in Arizona. Some of the smaller Arizona casinos include the Yavapi in Prescott, with 250 slots, 6,000 square feet, and ten dining table games; and the Spirit Mountain Casino in Mojave, with 260 slots and 9,500 square feet.
