



A season batting average of 0.220

Kim Ha-sung started as the 7th batter's shortstop in the 2024 Major League against the New York Mets at City Field in New York, New York, on the 15th (Korea time) and recorded two hits and one walk in three at-bats.

Kim Ha-sung, who failed to hit in two consecutive games following the Oakland Athletics match on the 13th, saw his batting average fall to 0.220 for the season.

Kim had his first at-bat in the top of the second inning with two outs and a runner on first base. Kim, who faced Mets starter Sean Manaea, picked out the first three balls before striking out two. Then, he threw a fumble at the sweeper flowing outward for the sixth ball and struck out.

In the top of the fifth inning, he faced Manaea once again with one out and no runners. This time, he counted in favor of three balls and one strike, and his fifth hit became a fly ball to right field.

Kim's only on base was in the top of the seventh inning. Trailing 1-2, Kim took the batter's box with two outs and a runner on first base, and faced third Mets pitcher Jake Deakman. After a tenacious game going up to the eighth pitch, he drew a walk and created a chance.

However, the score did not translate into a score. San Diego missed the chance to tie the game as follow-up hitter Jackson Merrill retired after hitting a fly ball to the left field.

San Diego failed to make a turnaround in the eighth and ninth innings afterwards, ultimately losing 1-2. He created a chance with two outs and a third base in his last attack in the top of the ninth inning, but Jake Cronenworth struck out and swallowed his regret.

Matt Waldron pitched well, allowing three hits, two walks, and two runs in seven innings, but became a losing pitcher. In the bottom of the third inning, J.D. Martinez hit a two-run double in a single crisis.

San Diego, which ended its three-game winning streak, maintained its second place in the National League West with a total of 37 wins and 36 losses in the season. [토토사이트 모음](#)
