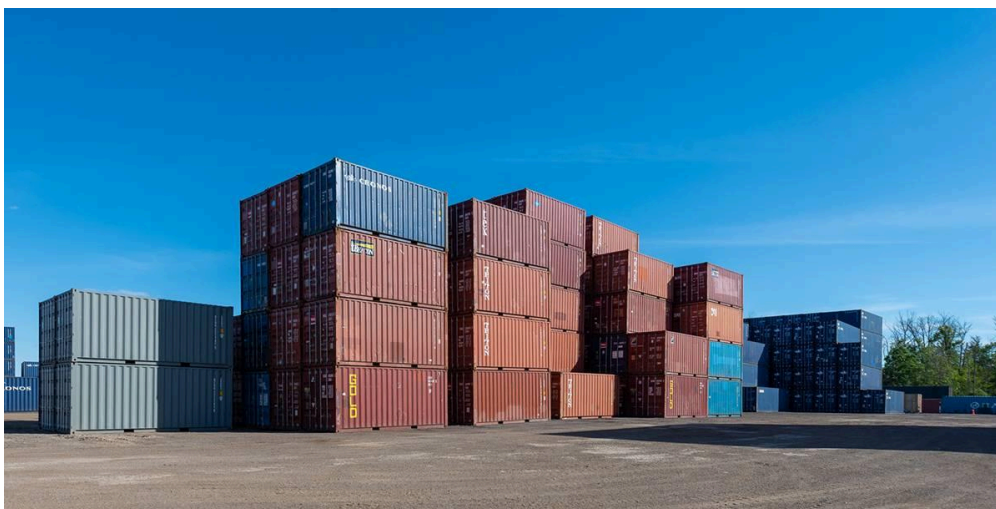




Storage Containers: Container Number

In a day, thousands of storage containers are being shipped from one part of the world to another, crossing border after border. Hence, to avoid confusion of any kind, each storage container is labelled by an internationally recognized organization with an identification number. It is also referred to as container number. The organization is The Bureau International des Containers. It regulates the container identification numbers since 1933 and promotes safe and secure transportation of containers across nations.



An identification number is given in each storage container, and it serves legal and any commercial purposes. It is printed or given on three sides of a container usually. They are visually found at the top of each container, one on the door and the other on the sidewall. This identification system enables uniform international identification of the containers. It also helps in the documentation and communication aspect of the containers being shipped from one place to another.

The identification number includes a BIC code that indicates the owner and consists of three letters in the capital. The next is the equipment category identifier having one capital letter. If it is "U", it stands for all freight containers. If it is "J", it stands for detachable freight container and "Z" for trailers or chassis. The next is the serial number which is six in total and in Arabic numeral. At last, there is the check digit which is also Arabic. For more information please visit <https://www.boxmeup.ca/>



The check digit provides validation and transmission that are accurate concerning the owner of the containers and the serial number. These numbers and letters serve to avoid any inconveniences as the goods pass one international border after another. The storage containers carry all kinds of manufactured products, enabling them to reach any destination safely. The containers are also product specific and custom-designed, and it makes any shipping of goods safer.
