

Instead, like many quartzite stones, this slab also hails from Brazil.

Quartzite countertops are a natural stone that is gaining popularity in the creative industry due to its marble-like beauty, granite-like sturdiness, and the vast choice of application alternatives. Quartzite is a metamorphic rock that develops naturally from sandstone and modifies over time under extreme heat and pressure. It's a naturally robust, heat-resistant stone that mimics marble but is more durable and resistant to scratches and other deterioration. It is found in quarries all throughout the world, but Brazil produces the more stunning and exotic designs. Quartzite has a hardness rating of 7 to 8 on the Mohs scale, which is equivalent to granite. It is scratch-resistant and acid-resistant, hence it will not etch when subjected to acids from citrus fruits and vinegar. Quartzite is suitable for work-tops, fireplace surrounds, breakfast bars, and practically any other use where granite would be appropriate. For households, this stone is becoming increasingly popular as a countertop material.
