When someone is arrested for a DUI, they lose their driver's license for a period of time. An attorney can help them request a hardship license. This allows the person to drive, with limitations, so they can continue to work while fighting the charges against them.

Look for Ways to Minimize Penalties

The attorney is going to do as much as possible to help the person minimize the penalties they're facing. Even if it's the person's first time being arrested, they are facing the possibility of jail time, fines, and other penalties. If they already have a DUI conviction on their record, they're facing more serious penalties, including a longer jail sentence and higher fines.

Find Ways to Avoid a Conviction

If possible, the attorney will look for ways to avoid a conviction. This commonly occurs if the police did not have a reason to stop the vehicle, if there was a mistake and the person was not over the legal limit, or if the evidence against the person is not valid and can be thrown out of court. This does not apply in all cases, but it is something an attorney will review.

Look for Alternative Ways to Handle the DUI

If the person has never been arrested before, it's possible they can look into a diversion program and have the conviction dismissed so it won't show up on their record. In these instances, the person will have to follow any rules given to them by the courts, including going

through a rehabilitation program. If they do all of this successfully, they may be able to avoid a conviction.
