LEGAL IMPLICATIONS INVOLVED IN SURORGACY IN COLOMBIA

Intended parents must know that surrogacy is available to everyone in Colombia. Yet, one must adhere to the rules and regulations laid down by the Colombian government in the same regards. Article 42-6 of Colombia's National Constitution states: "Children born in or out of wedlock, adopted, and procreated naturally or with the aid of science, have equal rights and obligations. The law will regulate regarding the responsible descendants.

The Constitutional Court's Sentence T 968 of 2009 provides the legal justification for including surrogacy arrangements via <u>surrogacy agency in Colombia</u> in this definition. On the other side, there is no express ban on the execution of these kinds of agreements as per surrogacy laws in Colombia.

Article 42-6 of the Constitution, which states that "Children born in Marriage or outside it, adopted or procreated naturally or with scientific assistance, has equal rights and duties," has been interpreted by the doctrine to legitimate assisted reproductive techniques, including surrogacy and surrogate motherhood.



WHAT DOES CONSTITUTIONAL COURT'S SENTENCE SAY IN SAME REGARD?

The necessary requirements and conditions of a surrogacy program between intended parents and surrogate are outlined in the Constitutional Court's Sentence T 968 of 2009, which includes:

- Intended parents are experiencing certain challenges while conceiving given to random medical issues
- The surrogate mother does not supply the gametes necessary for conception (there is no biological connection, so there is no such thing as traditional surrogacy; only gestational surrogacy);
- The process of surrogacy is altruistic and not commercial;
- The surrogate mother satisfies a number of criteria, including adulthood, physical and mental health, having children, etc.
- The surrogate mother must go through pertinent tests prior to, throughout, and after the pregnancy, as well as psychological assessments and necessary medical procedures under the guidance of surrogacy agency in Colombia

- Even if the surrogate is onboard for <u>surrogacy for HIV carrier in Colombia</u>, she has to undergo a list of additional tests and diagnosis
- The pregnant women cannot cancel the delivery of the child once they have signed surrogacy contracts and surrogacy agreements with their legal counsel and been implanted with the reproductive material;
- Once the child is born, the biological parents are unable to refuse the child under any circumstances;
- The child is still protected even if the biological parents pass away before the child is born;
- Only if her doctor gives the surrogate mother a medical indication can she end the pregnancy. Moreover, in case of surrogacy for HIV carrier in Colombia, every party involved need to clear the test and diagnosis required during the process.
