You would be surprised to know that even building materials can interfere with Wi-Fi signals. In old houses, chicken wire mesh was used in plaster to prevent cracking, so these metal wires can obstruct Wifi connection. Even a certain architectural feature in your house or a heavy filing cabinet can hamper with Wifi signal. The most effective way to eliminate those dead spots is by using an Internet booster.

2. Stop Struggling with Slow Wi-Fi: Do you face situations where you experience a slow Wifi signal in some parts of your home? Perhaps, you can't stream a video in your bedroom or can't attend a video conference call in the room upstairs. A lot of people just adjust with these annoying situations and continue to stretch working with slow Wi-Fi.
