



Eating in Iceland

So from mid-May to mid-August, the sunlight decreases for simply a couple of hours, which suggests that it is light almost all the moment.

The old-school Icelandic bakarí (bakeshops) can not be commended sufficient. A lot of towns have one (it may become part of a supermarket), which is normally open from 7am or 8am up until 4pm on weekdays (sometimes additionally Saturdays). These offer all type of economical fresh bread, buns, cakes, sandwiches and also coffee, and also typically offer chairs as well as tables to eat at. Every community and also village contends least one little supermarket. Nevertheless, during the winter season (October with April), snow storms can momentarily close the roadway, so you will need to maintain a close eye on weather condition and roadway conditions. Plus, you will certainly also have restricted daytime (or virtually no daytime at the top of winter months), offering you a smaller window of time for taking in the sights. During the winter season, having a 4 × 4 car is recommended. A trip on the Ring Road is among Iceland's ideal experiences.

If you don't rent out a car, you will certainly need to take a shuttle (concerning \$30 each) from Keflavik airport terminal into downtown Reykjavik and then prepare group trips with choice up as well as hand over from there.
